ELEMENTARY BOYS

Vendor: Any Choice (i.e. JCPenney, Lands End, Kohl's, Wal-Mart, etc.)

Please use uniform examples pictured below as your guide.

ITEM	STYLE AND COLOR REQUIREMENTS
Polo shirt (collared) <i>JCPenney selection meets requirements.</i>	Long or short sleeve, RIBBED BANDING ON THE SLEEVE , with or without pockets, ONLY 2-4 BUTTONS (NO SNAPS, VELCRO OR ALTERNATIVE CLOSURES) , any solid color, no patterns, insignias or brand symbols. Polo's with ALCS logos are permitted.
Turtleneck	Long or short sleeve, regular or mock, any solid color, no patterns or insignias
Oxford shirt (button down shirt with button collar) <i>JCPenney selection meets requirements.</i>	Long or short sleeve, light blue or white . Must have a button down collar.
Pants (cotton twill) <i>JCPenney selection meets requirements.</i>	Pleated (zipper fly; regular, straight, flared, tapered or boot cut; light or dark khaki, navy or black; no cargo or carpenter style; no draw string waists; no hip-huggers; no bell bottoms; no denim, knit or polyester material) JCPenney isn't currently offering a flat-front pant in their uniform selections.
Walking shorts (cotton twill, longer styles)	Pleated (zipper fly; cuffed or plain hem; black, navy, or khaki; no cargo style; no draw strings, no mid-thigh or shorter)
Cardigan sweater (cotton or acrylic)	Crew or V-neck; <u>navy</u> , <u>white</u> , <u>red</u> or <u>gray</u> ; button down front; no patterns or insignias; must be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck
Pullover sweater (cotton or acrylic)	Crew or V-neck; <u>navy</u> , <u>white</u> , <u>red</u> or <u>gray</u> ; no patterns or insignias; must be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck
Sweater vest (cotton or acrylic)	Crew or V-neck; navy, white, red or gray; no patterns or insignias; must be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck
Pullover sweatshirt <i>May not be worn on chapel days</i>	Crew neck, any solid color; no writing , no patterns or insignias except for official ALCS logos; must be worn with collared shirt or turtleneck. Hooded sweatshirts must be ALCS sweatshirt with school logo.



ELEMENTARY BOYS PERSONAL APPEARANCE GUIDELINES

BOYS REQUIRED CHAPEL DAY ATTIRE: Boys must wear the Standardized Dress pant selections (worn with a belt) with the oxford button collar shirt. Shirts may be layered with other approved Standardized Dress items. Shirrtails must be tucked in. Boys may not wear shorts, polo shirts or sweatshirts on chapel day. Turtlenecks may be used as layering with the oxford shirt.

BOYS EVERYDAY STANDARDIZED DRESS:

- Boys may not wear earrings to school.
- Hairstyles and accessories should not draw undue attention to the student. Elementary children's hair should not be color treated. Boys' hair may not be spiked and must be of an appropriate length.
- Straight hemmed shirts may be untucked; shirts with tails must be tucked in. T-shirts (plain or solid colors) may be worn for layering purposes only and must be tucked in.
- No over-sizing of pants. Pants are to be worn at the appropriate waist level.
- Collar buttons must be buttoned and dress shirts must be worn buttoned except for the top button.
- Coats and jackets are not to be worn during the school day; sweatshirts and sweaters are not to be worn around the waist.
- Caps, hats, bandanas and scarves are not to be worn inside the school building.
- Students may not wear flip-flop, beach slip-on or shower type sandals. Closed-back shoes or shoes with a strap in the back are acceptable.
- Students are not to wear pretend tattoos or markings with ink, markers, etc.
- Season for shorts: Weather permitting, students may wear shorts to school until Thanksgiving break and may resume wearing shorts after spring break. If temperature drops below 60° the other standardized clothing is required.
- Belts will be worn daily on pants that have loops.
- Special events: More formal attire is appropriate for special events. Special guidelines will be given by the teacher. Dress must be modest and appropriate.
