While we work to develop the new Dress Code for next year, these adoptions will go into effect immediately, for the remainder of the 2009-10 school year.

Goals remain the same:

1. Appropriateness of dress
2. Modesty
3. Conducive to learning environment
4. Representatives of Christ and the gospel
5. Comfort to students and cost to parents

Revisions for Non-Chapel Days:

- New for Elementary: may have striped polo shirts, chapel shirts or sweaters.
- New for Elementary: may have plain, solid color cotton twill or corduroy pants including cargo pants and Capri pants (after spring break)
- New for Elementary: may wear jeans the last Friday of every month

- New for Everyone: may have plain, solid color zipper sweatshirts – modest (in good taste) brand symbols/insignias acceptable

- New for MS/HS: a collared shirt no longer needs to be worn underneath crew neck or hooded sweatshirts
- New for MS/HS Boys: a collared shirt no longer needs to be worn underneath crew neck sweaters/shirts (not t-shirts)
- New for MS/HS Boys: shirts (straight line or tails) do not have to be tucked in
- New for MS/HS Girls: may wear a scarf with standardized attire
- New for MS/HS – may wear jeans every Friday
