PARENT ACCEPTANCE PLEDGE:

In consideration for enrollment of our child at ALCS, we agree to be bound by and will adhere to the following terms and conditions:

TUITION & FEE PAYMENT - I fully accept the tuition schedule and realize that no refunds may be made on registration and textbook fees. I hereby pledge to pay my financial obligation to Abundant Life Christian School on or before the due date. I agree to pay a \$20.00 late fee for any payment received by ALCS after the payment due date.

COMMUNICATION - I understand that communication and interaction between parents, students, faculty and administration is encouraged. However, communication will be carried on in a constructive and Biblical manner, reflecting confidence in the role of this school in training the student (Matthew 18).

CONFERENCES - At least one (1) parent is required to attend both the fall and spring conferences for elementary students. Secondary parent(s) are encouraged to attend conferences. Attendance becomes mandatory for parents of any student on probation, students who have earned a D/F grade, or as requested by staff.

GRADE & CLASS PLACEMENT - Students may be tested to determine academic standing. The school reserves the right to determine both grade level and class placement. ALCS places students through a process, not by parental request.

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT/PARENTAL PLEDGE - I have read the ALCS Student Code of Conduct and Handbook, and have discussed it with my child. Because students in grades 6-12 have agreed to conduct themselves according to this code, I will cooperate and support the school administration in the event that my child chooses actions or behavior that are not within the Student Code of Conduct. I understand the standards of ALCS do not permit weapons, profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Holy Trinity and the Word of God, or disrespect to the staff of ALCS. Failure to partner with ALCS regarding above behaviors could result in dismissal of my student from the school. I support the core values and Statement of Faith of Abundant Life Christian School.

DISCIPLINE - I believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student as well as the entire school. I give permission for school administrators, teachers, and support staff to make and enforce school regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures. ALCS reserves the right to change or enlarge its policies, written or otherwise, at anytime.

LOCKERS/DESKS - I understand that school lockers and desks are property of the school and that the school has a right to open and search desks and lockers. The school is not responsible for items/articles lost or stolen. Damages to school property will be assessed and charged to the party responsible.

LIABILITY - I give permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school sponsored trips away from school premises, and absolve the school from liability to me or my child at school or during any school activity. Recognizing the Biblical command against believers going to court against each other (1 Cor. 6:1), I agree that should a potential legal issue arise for any reason, I will not seek legal recourse through the court system, but agree to be bound by Christian arbitration. Should I choose to deviate from this agreement, I agree to pay any attorney fees, arbitration fees, damages and costs incurred by ALCS or its agent to defend itself against such actions.

WITHDRAWAL NOTICE - Should I choose to withdraw my child, I will contact the school to initiate the formal withdrawal process. If withdrawal comes at a time other than at the end of a quarter, tuition will be calculated on a half-quarter basis. Until mid-term grades are reported (mailed), I will only be charged for a half quarter. After mid-term grades are posted, tuition for the full quarter will be charged. I also agree to give advance notice of not less than 14 days and will complete a personal exit interview. Student records will not be released until all school obligations have been met.

FAMILY STATUS - I understand that, should my circumstances concerning the custody of my child change, I will contact the school office. This also applies to changes in address, telephone numbers, medical information, church membership, etc. ALCS acknowledges the Biblical definition of family; recognizing that marriage is between one man (father) and one woman (mother). A parent will be considered to be either the father or mother of the student (biologically or by adoption), a stepparent by subsequent marriage to the mother or father, or the legally appointed guardian.

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT - I pledge to help my child succeed at ALCS by providing homework support and behavioral guidance. In addition, I commit to one parent attending each of the two PTF meetings this year.

ATTENDANCE - I will ensure promptness, regular attendance and compliance with school policies, faithfully observing the mandatory attendance laws of the State of Wisconsin by requiring my child to be timely and in attendance.

Abundant Life Christian School Student Code of Conduct is established as a means of communicating and understanding the lifestyle standards agreed upon for our students and by our students. Each standard addresses choices that students are capable of making and acting upon as individuals. The expectations apply to ALCS students whether the student is in school or out of school. An unwillingness to make one's best effort to meet these standards also implies a choice to not continue as a student at Abundant Life Christian School.

1. I will recognize and respect the authority of my parents and govern my behavior, actions and attitudes accordingly.
2. I understand that by enrolling as a student at Abundant Life Christian School, I am accepting all school policies – those outlined in the student handbook and those established by the school administration.
3. I will fully and cheerfully adhere to the ALCS Standardized Dress Code policy as administered by the school to promote excellence in character development, modesty and propriety in appearance.
4. One of the primary reasons for enrolling as a student at Abundant Life Christian School is academic training. I realize that I am expected to put forth my best effort in homework, in preparation for quizzes and tests, and in special academic projects. I will be a blessing to my classmates and teachers and agree to contribute to the positive classroom atmosphere.
5. I understand that communication and interaction between parents, students, faculty and administration is encouraged. Communication will be carried on in a constructive and Biblical manner.
6. I will not participate in the following:
 - a. Possession of any kind of weapon or look-alike weapon on school grounds
 - b. Gossiping (repeating information about others that is not my concern or not edifying, whether it is true or untrue)
 - c. Slander (repeating information about others that is untrue)
 - d. Mockery (disdainful or disrespectful talk about those in authority, the church, or scriptural principals)
 - e. Profanity, Obscenity, Vulgarity, Offensive Slang
 - f. Destructive and self-destructive behaviors
7. I will not lie, cheat or steal. I am not only expected to adhere to this policy but also to promote and encourage my peers to do the same. I will neither cooperate in nor cover-up such incidents of which I become aware (Lev. 19:17b)
8. I understand that Abundant Life Christian School has standards of sexual conduct and social behavior that are based on Biblical truth rather than those of the culture, the popular media or peer groups. I will govern my behavior according to these standards.
9. I will refrain at all times from the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and pornography since these are certain destroyers of self-discipline, self-control, and are definitely against God's plan.
10. I understand that the sovereignty of Jesus Christ is challenged by various forms of alternative teachings (ie. occult, humanism, new age practices/teachings). I will not be involved in these things (Romans 12), and I will not promote their practice among other students.
11. I will maintain Christian standards of courtesy and kindness in the way I treat others. I will demonstrate respect for my fellow students and staff in my speech, attitudes and actions.
