STANDARDIZED DRESS CODE

BOYS NON-CHAPEL DAY DRESS CODE:

ITEM	REQUIREMENTS
Collared Shirt	Polo shirt or button-down-the-front shirt. Solid colors, stripes or plaids are acceptable. May include <u>SMALL</u> insignia or brand symbol.
Pants	Plain, solid color, cotton twill or corduroy pants with a natural waist, button closure and zipper fly. Cargo style pants meeting these requirements are acceptable.
Shorts (May be worn before Thanksgiving and after Spring break)	Solid color or plaid, cotton twill with a natural waist, button closure and zipper fly; must fall at mid-thigh or below. Cargo style shorts meeting these requirements are acceptable.
Sweatshirt	Solid color or ALCS logo apparel acceptable. Pull-over sweatshirts in good repair may be worn without a collared shirt beneath. <u>Zip-up sweatshirts must be worn with a collared shirt underneath.</u> May include <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols.
Sweater	Cardigan, Crew, or V-neck; solid color or stripes are acceptable. <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols are acceptable. Crew neck sweaters may be worn without a collared shirt beneath. V-neck and cardigan sweaters must be worn over a collared shirt.
T-shirts	May be worn underneath a collared shirt or sweater for layering purposes only. Writing or patterns <u>cannot</u> be visible through outer shirt.

BOYS CHAPEL DAY DRESS CODE:

ITEM	REQUIREMENTS
Dress Shirt (Required item: if sweater is worn, a dress shirt must be underneath)	Collared button-down-the-front shirt. Solid colors, stripes or plaids are acceptable. May include <u>SMALL</u> insignia or brand symbol.
Pants	In addition to the regular standardized pants, dress pants are also acceptable. Note: cargo pants are not allowed on chapel days.
Sweater	Cardigan, Crew or V-neck; solid color or stripes are acceptable. <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols are acceptable. Note: sweaters must be worn over a dress shirt on chapel days.
T-shirts	May be worn underneath dress shirt for layering purposes only. Writing or patterns <u>cannot</u> be visible through outer shirt.
Tie	Boys are encouraged to wear a tie, but they are optional. When wearing a tie, top shirt button may be left unbuttoned.

JEANS DAY DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

Friday is Standardized Dress “Blue Jean Day”. Only plain, blue jeans (blue color only) worn at the natural waist and in good repair may be worn. Students are expected to wear a shirt from the Non-chapel Day Dress selection above, unless the Principal has announced otherwise. (K4 – 12th)

GIRLS NON-CHAPEL DAY DRESS CODE:

ITEM	REQUIREMENTS
Shirt	Polo shirt or, button-down-the-front shirt. Solid colors, stripes or plaids are acceptable. May include <u>SMALL</u> insignia or brand symbol.
Pants	Plain, solid color, cotton twill or corduroy pants with a natural waist, button closure and zipper fly. Cargo style pants meeting these requirements are acceptable.
Shorts (May only be worn before Thanksgiving and after Spring break)	Solid color or plaid, cotton twill with a natural waist, button closure and zipper fly; must fall at mid-thigh or below. Skorts that meet these requirements are acceptable for elementary girls.
Capri Pants (May only be worn before Thanksgiving and after Spring break)	Solid color, cotton twill, with or without pockets; must have a natural waist, button closure and zipper fly.
Sweatshirt	Solid color or ALCS logo apparel acceptable. Pull-over sweatshirts in good repair may be worn without a standardized shirt beneath. <u>Zip-up sweatshirts must be worn with a collared shirt underneath.</u> May include <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols.
Sweater	Cardigan, Crew or V-neck; solid colors or stripes are acceptable. <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols are acceptable. Crew neck sweaters may be worn without a collared shirt beneath. V-neck, cardigan, & scoop-neck sweaters (neck line dipping below the collarbone) must be worn over a collared shirt.
T-shirt/Undershirt/Cami	May be worn underneath collared shirt or sweater for layering purposes only. Writing or patterns <u>cannot</u> be visible through outer shirt.

GIRLS CHAPEL DAY DRESS CODE:

ITEM	REQUIREMENTS
Blouse	Collared, button-down-the-front blouse. Solid colors, stripes or plaids are acceptable. May include <u>SMALL</u> insignia or brand symbol.
Skirt (Skirts must fall at or below the knee)	Plain, solid color skirts with a, finished hem. Splits or slits should not extend above the knee. Solid* color jumpers meeting the length requirement are acceptable for elementary girls.
Pants (May only be worn after Thanksgiving and before Spring break)	In addition to the regular standardized pants, dress pants are also acceptable. Note: cargo pants are not allowed on chapel days.
Sweater	Cardigan, Crew or V-neck; solid colors or stripes are acceptable. <u>SMALL</u> insignias and/or brand symbols are acceptable. Crew neck sweaters may be worn without a collared shirt beneath. V-neck, cardigan, & scoop-neck sweaters (neck line dipping below the collarbone) must be worn over a collared shirt.
T-shirt/Undershirt/Cami	May be worn underneath blouse for layering purposes only. Writing or patterns <u>cannot</u> be visible through outer shirt.

**JC Penney plaid jumpers and skirts are being phased out. You may continue to wear them yet this year.*

JEANS DAY DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

Friday is Standardized Dress “Blue Jean Day”. Only plain, blue jeans (blue color only) worn at the natural waist and in good repair may be worn. Students are expected to wear a shirt from the Non-chapel Day Dress selection above, unless the Principal has announced otherwise. (K4 – 12th)
