



High School Graduation Requirements

We offer a challenging curriculum and a variety of educational opportunities to our students. At the high school level, we use a combination of Christian and secular materials, which best fit our instructional goals in each academic area. All subjects are taught from a Christian perspective.

All students must maintain a minimum of 6.0 credits per academic year. 24 credits are required for graduation. Each course is a ½ credit per semester.
