

# MAISL Weather Policy – Updated January 5, 2018

MAISL at the request of participating school administrators has developed the following policy if we have Advisory and/or Warning statements issued by the National Weather Service

These are based upon NOAA weather sources (National Weather Service)  
Not local news station weather forecasting

- 1 – In the event of an Advisory, games will continue as scheduled  
This is either a winter storm or windchill advisory
  - 2 – In the event of a Wind Chill Warning, no games will be played (see note below)
  - 3 – In the event of a Winter Storm Warning being issued by the National Weather Service, no games will be played (see note below).
  - 4 – Independent Tournaments will be determined by the site hosting the tournament.  
MAISL will not make that decision

## **Clarification on cancellation of MAISL scheduled games if a “Warning”:**

### **For Saturday games:**

If MAISL is aware of a warning issued by National Weather Service and we can make a decision by 6:00PM on Friday for Saturday morning games we will inform MAISL Reps and post to MAISL website as well as MAISL Message Center (845-2333)

*Partial Saturday cancellation:* If National Weather Service posts a warning starting in the afternoon MAISL reserves the right to play games scheduled in the morning prior to the warning being implemented

### **For Sunday games:**

If National Weather Service has issued a warning before 8:00AM we would cancel games and post at that time, if issued later we will try to make sure people are informed by 10:00AM via the options listed above

---

MAISL participating school Principals have agreed that they will not close their venues or request that their teams not participate if we are under an “Advisory”. All teams will be expected to show for their scheduled game and failure to do so will result in a forfeit
